Advent Giving Tree 2023

ur Lady of the Lake's Advent Giving Tree returns next weekend! The tradition began in 2008 as a way to participate in social outreach based on Catholic Social Teaching. Through the Giving Tree, parishioners are given the opportunity to share their blessings with the most marginalized in the Portland area - those living on the streets and those at risk of becoming homeless. Our parish has consistently responded with generosity and compassion.

Working with Our Partners

The Advent Giving Tree will focus on fulfilling specific requests from our partner agencies, who distribute our donations and know the needs firsthand. Our partner agencies include many that have been receiving our Meals of Mercy -The Father's Heart, Rose Haven Shelter for Women and Children, Martha Mercado's outreach to the Latino working poor, and First Christian Church – as well as the expectant mothers and families served by the Mother and Child Center. The Mother and Child Center offers free services and supplies to anyone parenting, including single parents and families facing challenges such as lack of housing, poverty, fleeing domestic violence, refugee or immigration status, substance abuse, or trauma. We

will also assist Catholic Charities refugee resettlement through online giving.

Focus on Families

The tree located in the parish center atrium will emphasize the needs of children living in poverty and will include the option of donating gift cards. Perhaps the best way to help a family in need this Christmas is to donate

a gift card and allow parents the dignity of choosing the gifts their children receive.

There will be three ways to participate in the Giving Tree:

• Choose a tag to purchase an item; return your unwrapped gift to the tree located in the narthex, outside the parish hall, or in the parish center atrium.

• Choose a tag to purchase a Fred Meyer or Target gift card which will help families in need through the Christmas season; follow return instructions on the tag.

We will begin receiving donations on Sunday, November 26, and will continue collections through Sunday, December 17. Thank you in advance for bringing the joy of Christmas to our

brothers and sisters in Christ, especially at a time when many service agencies are struggling to meet their needs.





RESPECT LIFE



"Protecting Pain-Capable Unborn Children from Late-Term Abortions Act"

Recently Most Reverend Michael F. Burbidge, Chairman, Committee on Pro-Life Activities. wrote to Senator Graham regarding "Protecting Pain-Capable Unborn Children from Late-Term Abortions Act", Here is an opportunity to contact your representatives in support of this very important legislation. Please lend your voice with the USCCB Pro-Life Committee in calling on all elected officials, at all levels of government, including members of Congress at the federal level to protect preborn human life to co-sponsor and support this legislation.

Excerpts of Bishop Burbidge's letter to Senator Graham:

"Science continues to reveal the amazing development and characteristics of babies in utero, such as their ability to respond to music, to their mother's voice, and to other stimuli. Furthermore, there is significant scientific evidence that babies can feel pain as early as 12 weeks' gestation. In a collaborative report, "Reconsidering Fetal Pain," that was published in the Journal of Medical Ethics, scientists summarized their findings in part: "Overall, the evidence, and a balanced reading of that evidence, points towards an immediate and unreflective pain experience...from as early as 12 weeks... [W]e no longer view fetal pain...in a gestational window of 12–24 weeks as impossible based on the neuroscience

Further, not only does abortion end the life of the preborn child, but it is frequently harmful to the mother, emotionally and physically. Late-term abortions, such as those performed when the preborn child is 15 weeks or older, pose significant physical, and potentially fatal, risks to the mother.

The Catholic Church remains clear and consistent in asserting that true justice demands protection for the right to life, the most basic human and civil right, for every child, from conception onward. No person or government has the right to take the life of any innocent human being, regardless of his or her stage of development. We will never cease working for laws that protect human life from its beginning, supporting mothers in need, and ultimately making abortion unthinkable. It is long past time to provide more life-affirming alternatives that support and protect both mother and child."
